The South Carolina College Placement Association met at the Marriott Hotel in Atlanta, Georgia, at 2:00 P. M. on December 5, 1972, with Mrs. Daisy Dunn Johnson presiding. Those attending were: Frank W. Johnson, Bruce Stroupe, A. Oliver Martin, Greg Hughes, R. W. Ross, V. Deas Robinson, Arthur Clement, Jr., Julius E. Duke, Daisy D. Johnson, and Mae Kilgo. Mrs. Johnson explained that this organization was a year and a half old and that the reason for the meeting in Atlanta was that the Southern College Placement Association meeting there should insure good attendance. Mr. Ralph Malone of Fort Valley State College and President-elect of SCCPA was introduced and spoke a few words.

The minutes were read and adopted. The report from membership was not given as Mr. Henry Murphy was not present. Mrs. Deas Robinson of Claflin College reported for John Daniluk for the Constitution and By-Laws Committee which met on October 17, 1972, at Presbyterian College. She read the amendments. The group asked to go on record as commending the Committee for doing an excellent job. After some discussion, it was moved by Mr. Bruce Stroupe and seconded by Mr. Frank Johnson that the amendments be accepted.

## SOUTH CAROLINA COOPERATIVE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION

In April of 1976 The Professional Development Institute, University of Cincinnati, sponsored two seminars in South Carolina, for Educators and Employers interested in learning more about Cooperative Education. As a result of ideas exchanged during these seminars, a planning meeting was scheduled to discuss the possibility of establishing a state association. This key meeting was held on January 12, 1977 at Greenville Technical College. The first formal meeting of the South Carolina Cooperative Association was held on June 14, 1977 at the Beltline Campus of Midlands Technical College, Columbia, SC. At the June meeting, officers were elected, the constitution and bylaws were presented, and plans for a fall conference were developed. The Board of Directors meet for the first time, July 20, 1977 at Midlands Technical College.

From the first meeting in 1977, that attracted 9 employers and 13 educators, SCCEA continued to grow until it merged with the South Carolina College Placement Association in 1988. It served the needs of the Co-op community, both educators and employers, through its various programs and publications. More importantly, it allowed members to form a network within the state that helped enhance their skills, and improve their job performance.

This first formal meeting of SCCEA was held on Tuesday, June 14, 1977 in the Engineering Building at the Beltline Campus of Midlands Technical College, Columbia S.C. The financial report showed a balance of \$301.95

### PROGRAMS:

John Singley, Director of Co-Op Education and Placement at Midlands Technical College, welcomed the group and turned over the meeting to Roy Bonnell, Director of Co-Op and Placement at Spartanburg Technical College. He explained the process to become an association and presented the draft of the constitution and by-laws previously drawn up by the steering committee.

A general business meeting was held on Dec 1, 1977 at Hickory Knob State Park. President Robert Ostendorff called the meeting to order and welcomed the group of thirty-nine (39) attendees. Discussions at this meeting included membership of employers and students, committee activities, joint state meetings, the spring meeting and election of a nominating committee.

### ACTIVITIES:

Applications for membership were distributed. Robert Banister, Clemson University, emphasized the need to gain the State of South Carolina as a Co-Op employer. Bill Thornton emphasized the need to talk "Co-Op" at every opportunity, both personally and professionally.
