Costs for this speaker were covered by the Southeast Training Center for Cooperative Education. The Association decided to combine its spring meeting with the regional Co-op Conference that was being held in Charlotte, NC in May, 1986. At the business meeting held during the regional conference, Dave Scherrep raised the topic of a merger with SCCPA. The membership voted to approach SCCPA to see if they were interested in studying the idea.

The National Ad Campaign was renewed for 1986-87. Governor Carroll Campbell proclaimed the week of March 30 through April 4, 1987, as Cooperative Education Week in South Carolina.

### PROGRAMS:

1986-87 was a big year for SCCEA programs. In October, 1986 a joint meeting was held with the North Carolina Cooperative Education Association at the Blockade Runner Hotel in Wrightsville Beach, NC. During the business meeting it was announced that a joint committee headed up by Al Mathiasen had been set up to research the proposed merger of SCCEA and SCCPA. The spring meeting was held April 29 - March 1, 1987 at the Mills House in Charleston. At this joint meeting with SCCPA a vote was taken on the proposed merger. The proposal passed without disention, and a committee was appointed to work out the details. It was decided that the formal merger would take place in May, 1988. SCCEA co-sponsored a workshop for two year schools with the National Community College Center for Cooperative Education. This workshop was held June 25-26, 1987 at Horry-Georgetown Technical College, Myrtle Beach.
